Editorial: Side-effect of Member Care

I recieved some very encouraging replies in response to my editorial last month:

"..it is time for input in matters of the heart for local leaders / pastors/ missionaries in this fast growing indigenous church..."

"...There are also many, many people who are called to help local people rather than expats in areas of emotional need..."

"...Some member care providers also help meet needs of national people. Others feel they are not equipped to do so personally as they may not know enough of the language or culture. ..."

"... Thank you for raising the issue and awareness among the member care community. (...) are both pursuing how we can better engage in helping outside of traditional MC definitions...."

I thought I post it again, to draw out some more thoughts and replies from you:

Member Care focuses on the missionary. The definition says: Member Care is the ongoing preparation, equipping and empowering of missionaries for effective and sustainable life, ministry and work. Missionaries (according to local/regional definition). ... empowering missionaries for effective life and work...

I have been living in Asia for 15+ years now. As I and many others support foreign missionaries in Asia, I more and more realise that there is a side effect, a need, almost a cry-out for help: The local church and the local society is asking us for help.

Side Effect 1: After catastrophes there often are member care providers as first responders available to help and serve victims. THE WELL Member Care Center in Chiangmai Thailand set up a branch office in Southern Thailand after the Tsunami for 2 years, to serve not only missionaries, but also locals, the new churches, and devastated communities. Member Care by Media translated member care programs after earthquakes into local languages to support and encourage local victims and caregivers.

Side Effect 2: As societies and churches develop in less developed country, 'Heart' issues emerge. "We have bible teaching and teachings about christian spirituality, but we need to address issues of our heart". People are wounded due to historical wounds, war, trauma, culturally determined behaviours etc... Often these nations have no developed christian counseling resources. Member care providers are asked by locals through the missionaries to respond to needs. I am not talking about psychotherapy, but facilitated healing prayer, one another care, healthy community and church care, mentoring and coaching care, as well as counseling and psychological care. Often, we member care providers understand the "issues of the heart" better than others.

What do we do with this? Do we still call this member care?

For sure, member care providers have something that the local church in less developed countries is asking for.

Think about it, and let me know.
