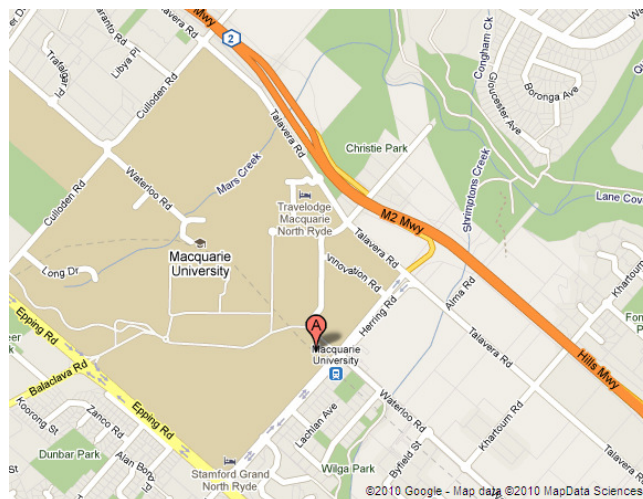

Bryan & Marion Knell



Bryan Knell is the Church Relations Director of Global Connections, UK. He has a degree in Engineering from Leicester University and a Cambridge Certificate in Religious Studies from the London School of Theology. Bryan's task in his role at Global Connections is to help mission agencies and churches to work better together; and to serve as a consultant to churches in the area of world mission.

Bryan's *'Encouraging World Mission'* provided a practical guide for churches and was published in 2002, while *'Churches and Agencies in Partnership'* published in 2006, focused on broader issues for the future of global mission.

Islam has been an interest for Bryan for 30 years and he teaches about Islam in churches around the UK. Bryan has been a governor of the London School of Theology and a member of the Council of the Evangelical Alliance.

Marion Knell is a trained secondary school teacher who now works as a Family Cross-Cultural Consultant with business, humanitarian and Christian companies. Marion lectures internationally on the subject of raising families overseas and on cross-cultural transition, adjustment and re-entry. Marion is the Co-ordinator of Member Care Europe.



In 2002 Marion's first book, *'Families on the Move – Growing up overseas and loving it'*, addressing cross-cultural parenting, was published. Her second book, *'Burn-up or Splash Down – the survival guide to re-entry'*, which focuses on re-entry issues for adults and teenagers, was published in May 2007.

Bryan and Marion have three adult children and five grand-children. In their spare time, Bryan enjoys outdoor activities and Marion is a fan of rugby football.
