

Take a break this summer!

This is your invitation to book a holiday at Rocky Point, the campsite in the Troodos Mountains, Cyprus. The camp is open to Christian workers and church groups. Please feel free to let other Christian workers in your area know about the camp.

Who can come?

Members of missions, churches and groups who have registered with Meco (who manage the site). As well as being used for conferences, retreats, youth week-ends, etc. (maximum sleeping accommodation - about 40 people) it is also for individuals and families.

Some churches come for day-trips and hold services on the site.

It is not rough camping, but an opportunity to relax and enjoy the quietness and beauty of the trees and mountains, and maybe share in fellowship with other campers as you desire.

Location

Located in pine forests at about 1500 m (5000 ft) elevation, and about 1.5 km from Troodos village, the site is ideal for camping. There are many good hikes from the camp, including to a rare tree over 600 years old, the beautiful Caledonia waterfall, and along meandering trails on the edge of the cliffs high above the valley floor.

Camping season

From Saturday 12th June to Saturday 25th September 2010.

Facilities

There are tents of various sizes (6 person to 1 person), most with beds and all with cooking utensils for self catering, and fridge space and washing machine are available. There may be some accommodation in the lodge.

A camp manager will be on site throughout the season to run the camp and give you all the help you need.

There are games (volley ball, table tennis) and a sand pit and play area for young children. The lodge is open each evening for fellowship, games, videos etc. There is even a small library for you to browse!

Cost

Ranges from €6 to €15 each, depending upon how many sharing, and whether tent or lodge. This includes water, electricity, gas, etc.
